b. Membership for students is likely to be waived again next year.

SP: Can we have a list of all geodesy graduate students across Canada? There are likely at least 15-20, why are we not getting ALL geodesy students in Canada to register? There is no other way that we can increase numbers across Canada.

MSa: Typically, GNSS students/professors are not as interested in CGU because there are other conferences/meetings that they prefer to go to. The last time that GNSS-related researchers were included in CGU was when we included a GNSS specific session in the conference and even then, they came to the session but then left and most did not become members.

SP: GNSS research sees themselves outside of our section but would be upset if they were told they are not geodesists, why is this? There needs to be a conscientious effort made to reach out to students. We need people from other places, research groups, etc.

7. New business [IF]

- a. Geodesy sessions for the next CGU meeting
 - i. Unification of height systems (Can, US, Mex)
 - ii. MSa: Quantum technology in geodesy
 - 1. Several options for invited speakers internationally
 - 2. Opens doors to other fields, researchers, etc.

MSa: Is there an option in CGU to offer a reduced registration fee for single-day/single-session registrations? Will there be an option to participate in sessions remotely next year? If so, will there be a reduced registration fee for this?

Action: IF to raise at next CGU Executive Meeting.

TJ: International workshop on GIA in Fall 2019, funded externally, ~65 participants. There's been interest in reconstituting something like this soon. TJ has formulated a proposal already and circulated for funding options. Could this kind of workshop be directly involved with CGU or at least along-side the CGU meeting? IF: Fully support this endeavour.

Action: IF to bring forward to greater CGU executive and set up meetings for future discussion.

Action: TJ provide list of abstracts from the last workshop from 2019 for circulation.

- b. IAG Delegate Election:
 - i. Current Delegates: Catherine Robin and Ismael Foroughi
 - 1. Catherine's term is ending, Ismael taking over as senior member. Need to elect a new junior member.
 - ii. CGU to provide new delegates to IUGG for the next 4 years
 - 1. Major roles are to provide a report on geodetic activities in Canada and vote on IAG executives.

Action: IF to contact IUGG delegate for further instructions on the process.

CK: Currently the delegates are both from NRCan, it would be nice to have some involvement from academia here as well.
