- a. SP: How many geodesy researchers, graduate students, affiliates, etc. exist in Canada? Can we reach out to the other disciplines? There are lots of potential for joint sessions, workshops, collaborations, etc. Geodesy has become one of the more prominent geosciences lately (internationally) but we tend to be quite quiet about what we're all about. Emphasis should also be made to have professors have their students registered as student members.
- b. IF: Especially true for the General affiliation memberships, we can send a notice to the whole of CGU to invite them to join the Geodesy section.
- c. SP: Common elements in work being done across Canada, expect that there are lots of research activities that are not being shared amongst the geodesy section. We should be trying to create a community of geodesists and communicating/collaborating better. Can we list the members and their research interests on our website? This would be a good start.
- d. CR: Can we tie into what is already happening (national publication lists, CGU newsletter if this still exists, etc.). What about looping in industry? There are lots of companies involved in geodesy-related work in Canada. Perhaps a social media presence as well would be useful. Future AGMs should also be held in a hybrid format.
