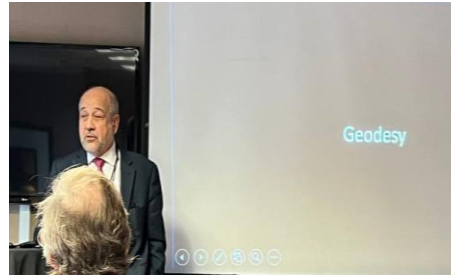


Geodesy Section report for 2023
